THIS NOTICE DESCRIBES HOW CHIROPRACTIC AND MEDICAL INFORMATION ABOUT YOU MAY BE USED AND DISCLOSED AND HOW YOU CAN GET ACCESS TO THIS INFORMATION, PLEASE REVIEW IT CAREFULLY.

In the course of your care at New Hudson Chiropractic Wellness Center, we may use or disclose personal and health related information about you in the following ways:

health care provider or hospital if it is necessary to refer you for further diagnosis, assessment or treatment.
*Your health care records as well as your billing records may be disclosed to another party, such as an insurance carrier, and HMO, a PPO, or your employer (if they are or may be responsible for the payments of your services).
Your name, address, phone number, and your health care records may be used to contact you regarding appointment reminders, to send thank you letters and referral letters, to send you birthday cards or promotions, to provide information about alternatives to your present care, or to other health related information that may be of interest to you.
*We may use your picture or your child's picture (if a patient) on Our Family Chiropractic board or your testimonial in our testimonial book displayed in the waiting room.
*In the course of delivering your care in an "open door" adjusting environment, routine details of your condition and care may be disclosed to other patients or staff in the approximate vicinity of where your care is being delivered.
*If you are not at home to receive an appointment reminder, a message may be left on your answering machine. Further, you have the right to inspect or obtain a copy of the information we will use for these purposes. You also have the right to refuse to provide authorization for this office to contact you regarding these matters. If you do not provide us with this authorization it will not affect the care provided to you or the reimbursement avenues associated with your care.

Under federal law, we are also permitted or required to use or disclose your health information without your consent or authorization in the following circumstances:

- If we are providing health care services to you based on the orders of another health care provider.
- If we provide health care services to you in an emergency.
- If we are required by law to provide care to you and we are unable to obtain your consent after attempting to do so.
- If there are substantial barriers to communicating with you, but in our professional judgment we believe that you intend for us to provide care.
- If we are ordered by the courts or another appropriate agency.

Any use or disclosure of your protected health information, other than as described in the examples outlined above, will only be made upon your written authorization.

We normally provide information about your health care to you in person at the time you receive chiropractic care from us. We may also mail information to you regarding your health care or about the status of your account. If you would like to receive this information at an address other than your home or, if you would like the information in a different form please advise us in writing as to your preferences.

You have the right to inspect and/or copy your health information for seven years from the date that the record was created or for as long as the information remains in our files (provided your account is in current order and at a zero balance). In addition, you have the right to request an amendment to your health information. Requests to inspect, copy, or amend your health related information should be provided to us in writing.

We are required by state and federal law to maintain the privacy of your patient file and the protected health information therein. We are also required to provide you with this notice or our privacy practices with respect to your health information.

We are further required by law to abide by the terms of this notice while it is in effect. We reserve the right to alter or amend the terms of this privacy notice. If changes are made to our privacy notice, we will notify you in writing as soon as possible following the changes. Any change in our privacy notice will apply for all of your health information in our files.

Information that we use or disclose based on this privacy notice may be subject to re-disclosure by the person or persons to whom we provide the information and may no longer be protected by the federal privacy rules.

If you have a complaint regarding our privacy notice, our privacy practices or any aspect or our privacy activities you should direct your complaint to New Hudson Chiropractic Wellness Center, 248-486-5684. You also have the right to lodge a complaint with the Secretary of the Department of Health and Human Services. If you choose to lodge a complaint with this office or with the Secretary your care will continue and you will not be disadvantaged by this office or our staff in any manner whatsoever.
